

Alyssum *Lobularia maritima*

Snow Crystals

Vigorous white alyssum produces mounds of sweet smelling flowers all summer long. Brighter white than 'Carpet of Snow' in last year's trials.



Bachelor Button *Centaurea cyanus*

Blue Boy

Blue Boy is the classic Bachelor Button. We've grown it in our cut flower gardens here at Spring Ledge for many years. Attracts beneficial insects and pollinators. Easy to grow corn blue flowers.



Basil *Ocimum basilicum*

Dark Opal

Mostly purple plants, with 20% variegated or green plants make a great color combo. Leaves avg. 1 1/2-3" at full size. AAS winner. Ht. 16-18".



Genovese Basil

Intensely scented strain of Sweet Large Leaf basil. Sweet, fragrant leaves are excellent for cooking, drying, and fresh eating. Keep compact by pinching frequently.



Black Eyed Susan *Rudbeckia fulgida*

Goldsturm

1999 perennial plant of the year. Long blooming bushy 'Black-eyed-Susan.' All summer 40-48".



Broccoli *Brassica oleracea*

Arcadia

Used in our fields for several years now along with 'Green Comet' - very nice sized heads of firm florets - dark green and delicious. Grows well in our neck of the woods.



Coneflower *Echinacea purpurea*

Magnus Blend

Rose purple, four-inch flowers with a dark rose center growing to 40-48 inches tall. Magnus is a cultivar identified by large flower heads and a tendency to hold its petals erect.



Dahlia *Dahlia pinnata*

Figaro Mix

Standard semi-double flowers on bushy uniform plants. Flowers are up to 2 1/2 inches across. Dark green leaves. Nice container or bedding plant.



Eggplant *Solanum melongena*

Nadia

Uniform, 7-8" long by 3-4" diameter, dark purple fruits are glossy and blemish free. Tall, sturdy plants can set fruit under cool conditions. Green calyx.



Greek Oregano *Origanum heracleoticum*

Greek

Heavy oregano aroma, great for pizza and italian cooking. Dark green leaves with white flowers.



Impatiens *Impatiens walleriana*

Beacon Salmon

Beacon impatiens offers high resistance to Impatiens downy mildew. For lasting colour, you can rely on Beacon impatiens to thrive.



Xtreme Mix

This mix includes bright shades of lavender, lilac, pink, red, rose, salmon, scarlet, violet, and white. Perfect for shaded garden beds and containers.



Lettuce *Lactuca sativa*

Red Sails

AAS Winner. The slowest bolting red leaf lettuce. Popular for salad mixes as well. Attractive, compact, fringed heads of deep burgundy red over green. Taste remains mild for a long time.



Romaine

We use 'Romulus', from Johnny's Selected Seeds in Albion, Me. Remarkably sweet and delicious. Broad, heavy dark green romain. 11-12 inch head. Slow bolting.



Salad Bowl

Delicate, lobed, lime-green leaves. AAS winner.



Speckled Amish

Open-pollinated. An ornamental bibb of spectacular beauty, its apple-green leaves splashed with maroon flecks. A stunner in your garden or salad. Makes small firm mild-flavored heads



Lupine *Lupinus russell hybrids*

Russel's Hybrids Mixed

The Russell hybrids are the most popular lupines. Self-sowing but with progeny whose colors are anyone's guess...makes life interesting.



Marigold - French *Tagetes patula*

Safari Mix

Early, compact dwarf with double anemone shaped flowers.



Marigold - Signet *Tagetes tenuifolia*

Signet Mix

Hundreds of petite flowers cover neat, low mounds of lacy foliage with a citrusy scent. Long-blooming for beds, borders and containers where it attracts beneficial insects such as hoverflies. Leaves of the plant are edible and are used as flavorful salad greens and garnish.



Onion *Allium cepa*

Yellow Onion Expression

Attractive, large, slightly-flattened bulbs with light brown skins. Expression's mild flavor was preferred in our trials. Will store for approx. 4 months. Better disease resistance than Candy, with high resistance to pink root; and intermediate resistance to fusarium basal rot.



Parsley *Petroselinum crispum*

Italian(plain)

The very best broad celery-leaf type with flat, glossy, dark green leaves. Its erect, vigorous growth and strong flavor make it the favorite for flavoring.



Pepper - Hot *Capsicum frutescens*

Jalapeno

Indispensable to Mexican cooking. often roasted or chopped. Dark green changing to red. Widely adapted.



Pepper - Sweet *Capsicum annuum*

Lady Bell

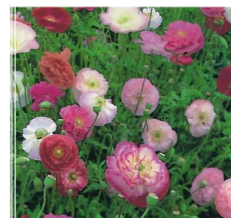
Larger fruit than Ace peppers. sweet bell pepper.



Poppy *Papaver rhoeas*

Shirley Double Mix

Incredible double blooms - blooms profusely. Stems should be cut underwater and seared for best results. Short vase life, but very stunning.



Salvia *Salvia coccinea*

Summer Jewel Pink

Winner of a 2012 All America Selection award, Summer Jewel Pink is a dwarf annual sage with super-abundant blooms of soft powder pink.



Sweet Pea *Lathyrus odoratus*

Mammoth Mixed

Best for cutting - sweet scented, ruffled edges in soft pastel colors. It needs to be trellised so it is great for fences and arbors.



Swiss Chard *Beta vulgaris*

Bright Lights

AAS Winner. Multicolor chard. Stems of many colors including gold, pink, orange, purple, red and white. Lightly savoyed leaves with a mild taste.



Tomato - Cherry *Lycopersicon esculentum*

Sweet Million

Dark red fruit, disease resistant and a standard cherry for Spring Ledge field production. An improvement over 'Sweet 100' in quantity and quality of fruits.



Tomato - Paste *Lycopersicon esculentum*

San Marzano

San Marzano tomatoes, a variety of plum tomatoes, are considered by many chefs to be the best sauce tomatoes in the world.



Tomato - Standard *Lycopersicon esculentum*

Better Boy

A standard large fruited hybrid - great for the home garden. Resistant to nematodes, verticillium and fusarium wilts. Fruit average of 1lb.



Verbena *Verbena bonariensis*

Bonariensis

Wiry stems bear flat panicles of purple flowers all summer long. Self sows. Nice cut flower. Great for pollinators. Butterflies love this flower! Self sows readily.



Zinnia *Zinnia angustifolia*

Zahara Double Mix

Excellent performance and durability in the landscape, especially in sunny, hot and dry conditions. Perfect in containers and mass plantings. Mix includes Cherry, Fire Improved, Salmon, Rose, Yellow and White. Annual. Height: 16-20".
